Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus asks us a stunning question this week:

"How can Satan cast out Satan?"

To enter into this question opens up the often-hidden dynamics of what Jesus has done and is constantly doing. If we're honest, our response to some degree is: "How else can we cast him out?"

Satan is precisely how we cast out Satan!"

But Jesus wants us to see this finally does not work.

Here's what I mean. Satan names the demonic mechanism by which we render wholeness through accusation.

When we face a threat, we seek something to protect us (e.g., more money, social status, security, power, etc.). Rivals inevitably arise for these things and so do tensions. Accusation presents itself. "I'll never be successful unless I get ahead of that guy." "She's already trying to get ahead of me." "That group of immigrants is trying to take our jobs." And so on. The accusation grows into a fear-inducing threat — things will break apart — no, they already are! Hurry! We inflict violence on the victim and — as if by magic — peace ensues. For a time. Soon fresh accusations are required to hold new chaos at bay, until there is no community left at all. This is essentially humankind's sad history in a nutshell.

Jesus' cross and resurrection unmasks this broken system of "casting out Satan by Satan" and ushers in a new one he calls "the Kingdom of God." He reveals that the dynamic of accusation is nothing compared to his power of divine mercy and love. The cross (and not Satan) is the real power to tear down strongholds of sin and cast out Satan. This is why he describes himself as the "stronger man who ties up the strong man to plunder his house." This week let's notice the ways we "cast out Satan by Satan," and then refuse to do it anymore. Because in the long run, that divided *house cannot stand*.

IT'S ALL ABOUT BEGINNING

"There is no way to happiness, happiness is the way." ~ Thich Nhat Hanh

Today's quote comes from a Vietnamese Zen Buddhist monk, teacher, and author. If you truly take the time to contemplate what he is saying, it is very simple yet, at the same time, incredibly profound.

We often look for fulfillment in our lives: personally, professionally, and spiritually. We look for the "quick fix." We look for the "magic bullet." We look for what will give us what we want in order to feel fulfilled.

The only problem is, when we finally get what we want, we never really feel fulfilled, do we? We think that there is always something more, some other milestone, some other goal, some other prize, some other pleasure just waiting for us to snare. So we make plans to go for that. And what lies beyond that. And what lies beyond that. If that is not the recipe for complete frustration, I do not know what is.

"There is no way to happiness, happiness is the way." I think that this simple, yet eloquent, quote would be embraced by people such as Mother Teresa of Calcutta. She never looked for the "big" goal. She looked for the simple and, in the process, produced huge results. She would say, "If you cannot feed a hundred people, then just feed one."

So many of us get lost in the desire to produce big, to achieve the most, to be recognized by all. In the process, we lose our bearing. We lose our very selves. If we want to find happiness, be happy. It does not take much to smile, to laugh, and to greet another with a smile and good cheer. If we do so, we transmit that happiness to the other person and receive it back in fuller measure.

I have said this so often but it bears repeating again. Growing in holiness is not about doing big things, it is merely about beginning. When we take the initial step, God takes our hand and guides us the rest of the way. If that initial step is over a rocky crevice, God takes our hand and lifts us over the obstacle. If that initial step meets us with force, God takes our hand and protects our soul. God will never fail us and He does not want us to fail ourselves.

Do not look for the big and mighty ways to make yourself a better Christian. Look for the simple, look for the plain, look for the authentic and then do it with confidence. God will supply the rest.

FAITH ACTION: Live your faith with confidence today and know that God will make up whatever is lacking.

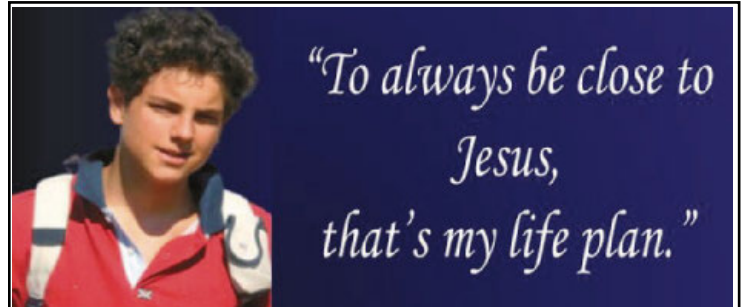


CONGRATULATIONS TO ALL OUR GRADUATES!

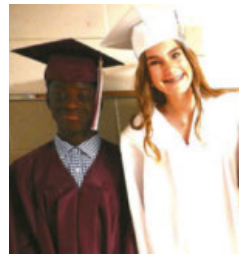
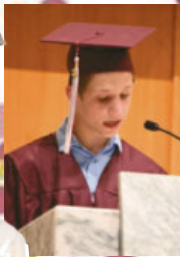
